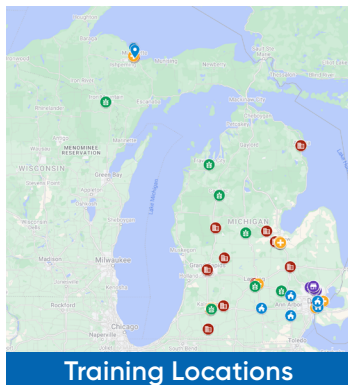


Making A Difference With MIDOCs

About MIDOCs

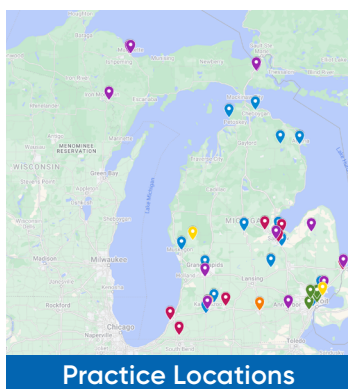
